# Do's and Don'ts



Do...

Tell bibic about your fundraising plans and stay in touch to let us know how it's going - our job is to help you, so let us know how we can!

Promote bibic! Fundraising also helps us to spread the word about our services so thank you! This also means you are a spokesperson for bibic which gives you the responsibility to maintain our good reputation.

Be clear that donations are going to bibic, funding our essential services.

Ask us about fundraising materials - we can help promote your fundraising through our website, social media, and provide you with a collection tin.

## Don't...



Use the bibic logo without seeking permission first - by law we have to give you our 'in support of' logo to support your efforts.

Forget to thank everyone who donates! Report back to them about how much your fundraising has raised and what it will be used for - we can keep in touch with you and help spread the news about the positive impact of your work.

Don't forget to get any necessary permissions - the council needs to provide permission for any street or door to door collections, licenses, selling alcohol of public entertainment.

### You must...

- Keep all funds raised in a safe and secure place separate from your own money.
- Keep details of all monies received or pledged, all events proceeds, a record of activities carried out and return sponsorship forms to bibic.
- Offer donations back to people should your event fail to take place.
- Any funds you receive belong to bibic and must be gifted to bibic straight after your fundraising event.
