Linkythinks aim to show that by linking different ways of thinking, we can give children the power and freedom to express themselves creatively, academically and emotionally. They provide ideas to form these linking thought processes both at home and at school.

'How do I feel?' wheel for mental health and emotional vocabulary

This is an interactive wheel to help children process and communicate different feelings using words and images. With two moving dials to help children pinpoint how they feel and how they are expressing it, for example a child may identify that they are excited, but are internally feeling unsure. It comes with a user guide to inspire lesson plans for school or at home activities. Appropriate for all ages and social communication needs.



Word wheels



With three age ranges (6-9 years), advanced (9-13 years) and pro (teens and adults) there is a resource available for all ages and stages of learning. Every booklet contains 10 wheels: verbs, adjectives, sentence openers, emotions, five senses, animals, nature, seasons and weather, colours and formal phrases. They are saturated with colour to aid with understanding and developing key ideas. Used to support writing across the curriculum.

Storygami

To help children who struggle to produce ideas or have too many this resource supports children to get started with their creative writing. It breaks stories down into four steps with guidance on what to write about, with a fiddle folding element and colouring. Boosting confidence in creative writing and story structure.
